# **Key Findings – President Biden**

- American Jews express extraordinary support for President Biden's response to Hamas's October 7 attack on Israel, and Jewish voters continue to be a base vote for Biden.
  - ▶ 66 percent approve of Biden's job performance as President.
  - > 74 percent approve of the way Biden is handling the war between Israel and Hamas.
- ➤ Jewish voters hold extremely negative views toward Donald Trump, and they continue to provide Biden overwhelming margins over Trump.
  - ➤ Biden leads Trump 68 to 22 percent in a 2024 match-up.
  - > 77 percent have an unfavorable view of Trump.
- Large majorities support American actions taken since October 7.
  - ➤ Biden's visit to Israel, sending two aircraft carriers to the region, attending Israeli war cabinet meetings, vetoing UN ceasefire resolution, and calling for a humanitarian pause all receive strong support.


# **Key Findings – Israel**


- ➤ American Jews are closely following the news coverage of October 7 and the war, and emotional attachment to Israel has grown.
  - > 97 percent are following the news closely, including 75 percent who are following it **very** closely.
  - > 82 percent feel emotionally attached to Israel, including 51 percent who feel **very** emotionally attached to Israel (an increase from 33 percent **very** emotionally attached in June 2023).
- Large majority want Congress to pass Biden's military aid request; similar levels of support for Israel and Israel + Ukraine.
  - ➤ 80 percent support \$14.3 billion in new military aid to Israel.
  - > 77 percent support \$74 billion in new military aid to Israel and Ukraine.
- > American Jews do not believe criticism of Israeli policy means someone is not pro-Israel.
  - ➤ 91 percent think someone can be critical of government policy and still be pro-Israel.
  - ➤ 76 percent think someone can be critical of how Israel is conducting the war with Hamas and still be pro-Israel.

# **Key Findings – Antisemitism**

- ➤ There is a notable increase in the degree of concern over antisemitism.
  - ▶ 93 percent are concerned about antisemitism in the United States, including 79 percent who are very concerned.
  - ➤ In September 2022, 64 percent were very concerned about antisemitism in the United States.
- Antisemitism in the United States and on college campuses are seen as serious problems.
  - ➤ 96 percent think it is a problem in the US, including 73 percent who think it is a *very* serious problem.
  - ➤ 91 percent think it is a problem on college campuses, including 67 percent who think it is a *very* serious problem.
- Racism and Islamophobia are also seen as serious problems.
  - > 91 percent think racism is a problem in the US, including 67 percent who think it is a *very* serious problem. 83 percent view racism as a problem on college campuses, including 53 percent who view it as a *very* serious problem.
  - > 78 percent percent think Islamophobia is a problem in the US, including 49 percent who view it as a **very** serious problem. 67 percent view it as a problem on college campuses, including 39 percent who think it is a **very** serious problem.









#### **Presidential Vote**

Thinking about the next election for U.S. President in November 2024, if the election for President were being held today just between the following candidates, for whom would you vote?






Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as president?







# Overwhelming Approval Of Biden's Handling Of The War, With Huge Age Gaps



Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling the war between Israel and Hamas?




















How closely are you following the news coverage of Hamas's October 7th attack against Israel and the war between Israel and Hamas?
























# Concern About Antisemitism Spans Denomination, Age, Gender, And Has Increased Among Certain Groups Since June

Darker shade = Stronger intensity



- GBAO designed the questionnaire for this national survey of American Jews for the Jewish Electorate Institute (JEI). The survey was conducted November 5-9, 2023 and included interviews with 800 selfidentified American Jews who are registered to vote. The survey is subject to a margin of error of +/- 3.5 percentage points at the 95 percent confidence level. Sub-groups are subject to a higher margin of error.
- The survey sample was drawn from a national voter file, consisting of all registered voters in the United States. Respondents with a likelihood of being Jewish, based on their first or last name or their geography, were contacted by text, and then took the survey on a secure link on their phone or computer if they identified themselves as Jewish.
- All respondents were asked at the beginning of the survey whether they consider themselves Jewish, using the same question wording as the 2020 Pew Research Center study, "Jewish Americans in 2020."
- The sample was weighted to Pew's demographic results on key variables, such as gender, denomination, age, and synagogue membership.
